**Foster Care & Adoption Information Meeting
Set for North Hill Branch Library on Wednesday, February 8**

AKRON, Ohio – January 2017 – Summit County Children Services is sponsoring a free Foster Care and Adoption Information Meeting on Wednesday, February 8 at 6 p.m. at the North Hill Branch Library, 183 E. Cuyahoga Falls Avenue, Akron.

Summit County Children Services presently has more than 670 children in custody. Of those children, 155 are in permanent custody of which 60 do not have an identified adoptive placement. So there is always a need for foster and adoptive parents. Those attending the information meeting will learn a variety of details about foster care and adoption including what and how long the process is, what kind of support is provided by the agency, and the minimal costs involved with adopting a child through a public agency such as SCCS. Agency staff will be available to share basic information about the children coming into care.
