**Diane L. Miller-Dawson Appointed
to Summit County Children Services Board of Trustees**

AKRON, Ohio – January 2017 – The newest member of the Summit County Children Services Board of Trustees is **Diane L. Miller-Dawson**, who was recently appointed to the board by County Executive Ilene Shapiro for a four-year term that will expire at the end of 2020.

Ms. Miller Dawson is the Director of Finance for the City of Akron. A lifelong resident, she is an alumna of Buchtel High School and attended The University of Akron where she earned her Bachelor's degree in management. She later returned to the University to pursue a Master's degree in business administration, which she received in 1994. During college, Ms. Miller-Dawson began her career with the City, her first job working in the recreation division. She has held various other positions in the City, including operations research analyst, operations research manager, and deputy finance director. In January 2004, Ms. Miller-Dawson was named finance director. The Finance Department includes the divisions of Audit and Budget, Purchasing, Accounting and Payroll, Taxation, Treasury and Management Information Systems (MIS). Ms. Miller-Dawson is very active in the Akron community. Some of her volunteer activities include member of Class 16 of Leadership Akron; Trustee of Cleveland Clinic Akron General Health System Board; member Delta Sigma Theta Sorority; Trustee of Akron Summit Solid Waste Authority – Reworks and Member of the Joint Board of Review.
