### RESOLUTION 03-2021-23/B

**WHEREAS**, the Akron-Summit County Public Library (Library) is seeking voter approval of its 1.9-mill renewal levy on the May 4, 2021 ballot; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Library provides resources for learning and leisure, information services, meeting spaces, and programs for all ages that support, improve, and enrich individual, family, and community life; and,

**WHEREAS**, Summit County families and children benefit from the services and resources provided by the Library; and,

**WHEREAS**, Summit County Children Services (SCCS) believes that passage of the renewal levy will further positive changes and support services to help strengthen and support Summit County families.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the SCCS Board of Trustees hereby authorizes:

That SCCS supports the Library as an important community partner in providing services which address the best interests of families and children in Summit County; and,

That SCCS hereby invests in the children of Summit County by endorsing the Akron-Summit County Public Library's Levy Renewal and authorizes the Citizens Committee and the Library to use the name of Summit County Children Services and to place signs and literature on the SCCS Campus for advertisements and general publicity purposes related to the levy campaign.

## SUMMIT COUNTY CHILDREN SERVICES

### RESOLUTION 03-2021-23/C

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 5153.34 authorizes the Summit County Children Services Board of Trustees to acquire such services as are necessary for the proper conduct of its work; and,

**WHEREAS**, the mission of Summit County Children Services (SCCS) is to serve abused, neglected, and dependent children and provide them with a variety of services to promote child safety, permanency, and wellbeing; and,

**WHEREAS**, consistent with the proper conduct of its work, in furtherance of its mission, and as required by Ohio law, SCCS routinely conducts criminal background checks through the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) utilizing the Ohio Attorney General's WebCheck fingerprinting program; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Administration now wishes to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Ohio Attorney General for use of the WebCheck criminal background check program for a three (3) year term; and,

**WHEREAS**, the cost of participation in the WebCheck criminal background check program is Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000) annually, for a **total cost which may be less than, but shall not exceed Two Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$210,000) over the three (3) year term** of the MOU.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the SCCS Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Administration to enter into an MOU with the Ohio Attorney General for the use of the WebCheck program for a **three (3) year term, in an amount which may be less than, but shall not exceed, Two Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$210,000)**.
