

Procedure: Medical Emergencies for Children in the Custody of SCCS

Procedure No.:

Purpose of the procedure:

To define the caregiver role in the event of a medical emergency of a child placed in the home.

Statement of procedure:

In the event of a life-threatening situation, the caregiver should immediately call 911 or another emergency number in their area. The SCCS hotline (330) 434-KIDS should be notified as soon as the situation is under control.

The SCCS hotline will be responsible for notifying the child's social worker. The child's social worker will notify the family, when applicable.
