**RESOLUTION 02-2024-27/B**

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 5153.34 authorizes the Summit County Children Services Board of Trustees to acquire such services as are necessary for the proper conduct of its work; and,


**WHEREAS**, the mission of Summit County Children Services (SCCS) is to serve abused, neglected, and dependent children and provide them with a variety of services to promote child safety, permanency, and wellbeing; and,

**WHEREAS**, consistent with the proper conduct of its work, in furtherance of its mission, and as required by Ohio law, SCCS routinely conducts criminal background checks through the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) utilizing the Ohio Attorney General's WebCheck fingerprinting program; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Administration now wishes to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Ohio Attorney General for use of the WebCheck criminal background check program for a three (3) year term; and,

**WHEREAS**, the cost of participation in the WebCheck criminal background check program is Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00) annually, for a total cost which may be less than, but shall not exceed, Two Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$210,000) over the three (3) year term of the MOU.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the SCCS Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Administration to enter into a MOU with the Ohio Attorney General for the use of the WebCheck program for a three (3) year term, in an amount which **may be less than, but shall not exceed, Two Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$210,000)**.

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 5153.34 authorizes the Summit County Children Services Board of Trustees to acquire such services as are necessary for the proper conduct of its work; and,


**WHEREAS**, the mission of Summit County Children Services (SCCS) is to serve abused, neglected, and dependent children and provide them with a variety of services to promote child safety, permanency, and well-being; and,

**WHEREAS**, consistent with the proper conduct of its work and in furtherance of SCCS' mission, SCCS currently has an agreement with a software service vendor to support foster care and adoption recruitment and retention which expires April 30, 2024; and,

**WHEREAS**, SCCS wishes to continue to receive software services to support foster care and adoption recruitment and retention and must identify a vendor to provide such services; and,

**WHEREAS**, in order to identify the best qualified vendor of such software, SCCS must issue a Request for Proposals (RFP) in accordance with the requirements of the SCCS Procurement Plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the SCCS Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the SCCS Administration to issue a RFP for software services to support foster care and adoption recruitment and retention in order to identify a qualified vendor to provide such services.
