**RESOLUTION 03-2026-24/A**

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 5153.34 authorizes the Summit County Children Services (SCCS) Board of Trustees to acquire such services as are necessary for the proper conduct of its work; and,

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution 02-2024-27/C, the SCCS Administration released a Request for Proposals (RFP) to identify a qualified provider of Foster Care and Adoption and Family Finding Software; and,


**WHEREAS**, SCCS received two (2) proposals in response to such RFP and identified Binti, Inc., a California-based corporation, as the most advantageous vendor of a software service to support foster care and adoption recruitment and retention and family finding; and,

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution 04-2024-23/D, SCCS entered into an agreement with Binti, Inc. for the purchase of its software service to support foster care and adoption recruitment and retention and family finding over a two-year period to commencing May 1, 2024; and,

**WHEREAS**, SCCS now wishes to extend such agreement with Binti, Inc. for **a three-year period to commence May 1, 2026 in the amount not to exceed Three Hundred Seventy-One Thousand Dollars (\$371,000.00)**; and,

**WHEREAS**, if further extensions to the agreement are contemplated, the SCCS Administration will seek further authorization from the SCCS Board of Trustees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the SCCS Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the SCCS Executive Director to enter into an agreement with Binti, Inc. for the purchase of its software service to support foster care and adoption recruitment and retention and family finding **over a three-year period to commence May 1, 2026 in the amount not to exceed Three Hundred Seventy-One Thousand Dollars (\$371,000.00)**.

**WHEREAS**, Caring for Kids, Inc. submitted a qualified and advantageous proposal in response to the Request for Proposals for Foster Care and Adoption Home Studies; and,

**WHEREAS**, the SCCS Administration has evaluated the proposal of Caring for Kids, Inc. as fitting the needs of SCCS and desires to execute a one-year agreement with Caring for Kids, Inc., effective April 9, 2026, with the option for three (3) additional one-year extensions, **in an amount that may be less than but shall not exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) annually.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of Trustees of Summit County Children Services hereby authorizes the Executive Director to execute a one-year Agreement for Foster Care and Adoption Home Studies with Caring for Kids, Inc., effective April 9, 2026, with the option to contract with Caring for Kids, Inc. for an additional three (3) one-year extensions, at a **total amount that may be less than but shall not exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) annually.**

**WHEREAS**, Adopt America Network submitted a qualified and advantageous proposal in response to the Request for Proposals for Foster Care and Adoption Home Studies; and,

**WHEREAS**, the SCCS Administration has evaluated the proposal of Adopt America Network as fitting the needs of SCCS and desires to execute a one-year agreement with Adopt America Network, effective April 9, 2026, with the option for three (3) additional one-year extensions, **in an amount that may be less than but shall not exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) annually.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of Trustees of Summit County Children Services hereby authorizes the Executive Director to execute a one-year Agreement for Foster Care and Adoption Home Studies with Adopt America Network, effective April 9, 2026, with the option to contract with Adopt America Network for an additional three (3) one-year extensions, at a **total amount that may be less than but shall not exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) annually.**
