How the SCCS 'Foster Friendly' Program Works

- 1 Choose a discount or free item
- 2 Foster parents present their ID to receive the discount or free item

As an SCCS 'Foster Friendly' site, your business will be added to an ongoing list that will be shared with our foster families, and your location will receive recognition via the agency's social media platforms and website.

FOSTER PARENT IDENTIFICATION

Each certified Summit County Children Services (SCCS) foster parent has an official identification badge. Foster parents will be instructed to present their SCCS ID badge before receiving your business's discount or offer.

PROMOTE THE PROGRAM

As a member of the Foster Friendly Business Program, you will receive promotional items, like window decals and tabletop displays, that will indicate your membership to your customers. Display these items proudly on windows, counter tops, near cash registers, or any other high-traffic area.
